



LEGOLAND Holiday Village: Spend a night in the LEGO world

One day alone is not enough to fully explore all nine adventure worlds at LEGOLAND Deutschland. That is why the family amusement park has expanded its amenities and developed into a short trip destination. In 2008, the Holiday Village was built next to the park, which has been steadily expanded and now has 72 cottages, a campground and a splendid castle complex with 136 LEGO themed rooms. Along with these accommodation options, LEGOLAND Holiday Village also has a lake with a sandy beach, a bowling-center, a high-ropes course and a minigolf course, and many other entertaining things to do.

In its nine adventure worlds LEGOLAND Deutschland Resort offers its guests more than 55 different attractions, models made from more than 56 million LEGO bricks and live entertainment shows. At the LEGOLAND Holiday Village, guests can continue their adventures even after the park itself has closed down for the evening. The Holiday Village is just a five-minute walk from the park, using a second entrance in the KINGDOM OF THE PHARAOHS.

Wide range of accommodation options for knights, pirates, princesses and the like

Nestled in a forested landscape, the 72 holiday cottages are built to reflect different LEGO themes, each with two family rooms. The campground offers 175 pitches for mobile homes, caravans and tents. There are also LEGO themed Camping Barrels which can accommodate up to four persons each. 14 with pirate theming and 25 Camping Barrels with wilderness decor. These rustic Barrels feature a sleeping area and a small living room space which can be converted into a children's sleeping area.

Furthermore, guests can stay at the splendid castle complex, with the Knight's Castle, the King's Castle and the Dragon's Castle. The King's Castle is the largest of the three, with 68 family rooms on three floors. Like the Knight's Castle, the Dragon's Castle also has 34 LEGO themed rooms. All rooms feature two separate sleeping areas, with a kingsize bed for the parents and a bunk bed for the kids, along with a bathroom. The rooms are charmingly decorated, featuring models made of approx. 5,000 LEGO bricks in each family room, transforming the accommodations in a veritable LEGO kingdom.

Staying at one of the twelve larger king's rooms for up to five persons is a particularly luxurious experience. Castle guests certainly won't go hungry, thanks to the restaurant "The Round Table" on the ground floor, with an outdoor terrace, and the castle bar "King's Tavern". Princesses and princes can enjoy outdoor playtime and fun at the adventure playground.

Just like the Castles, the design of the 72 themed cottages with two family rooms each, is also oriented to the adventure worlds in the Park and let children's dreams come true: Sleeping like a pirate, a racecar driver or a treasure hunter. All of the 4 bed rooms have two separate sleeping areas with a double bed and a bunk bed. The 6-bed rooms have an open living room, with a double bed and a bunk bed, along with two single beds on a mezzanine level. Some of the rooms are connected by doors and can thus be used by a maximum of eight guests. One barrier-free cottage is wheelchair accessible.

Delicious meals and even more fun and games at the Holiday Village

The central dining complex at the LEGOLAND Holiday Village has two more restaurants to satisfy everyone's desires. At the Jungle Buffet, different themed buffets are served every day, whilst the Steak House offers grilled specialties from its open kitchen. So in total the Holiday Village offers more than three restaurants and two bars. After a day of fun and action at the park, parents can spend a relaxing evening on the terrace, whilst children build sandcastles on the beach or play at the adventure playgrounds. For guests who want to experience the LEGOLAND Park by night, there are also exclusive offers such as an evening show at the 4D cinema or night tours of the underwater world of LEGOLAND ATLANTIS by SEA LIFE.

The LEGOLAND Deutschland Holiday Village reached the first place in the Travelers' Choice Awards 2017 in the category "Best Family Hotel in Germany." The award was given out by TripAdvisor.
